RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE ENERGY CONSERVATION COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the traditional American way of life causes Americans to consume a disproportionate share of the world's oil, and

WHEREAS, energy conservation is a vital national concern to preserve a high quality of life for its citizens, and

WHEREAS, the assembly has resolved to take substantial measures to reduce the use of petroleum within the city and borough and plan for imminent allocation restrictions and possible shortages of petroleum products,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That there is created the Energy Conservation Committee.
2. That the Committee shall consist of thirteen members to be representative of the general population and energy-related entities. Members will be selected as follows:
 - a. One bulk petroleum products distributor.
 - b. One retail gasoline distributor.
 - c. One electric utility representative.
 - d. One U.S. Forest Service representative.
 - e. One representative of the Governor.
 - f. One architect or engineer engaged in building design.
 - g. Seven representatives of the general public, including lower income persons, public transit users, and others with an interest in energy conservation.
3. The term of the Committee shall be until June 30, 1981.
4. That the Committee
 - a. Propose a petroleum product allocation

and distribution plan in the event that a petroleum product shortage occurs.

b. Propose a plan to reduce the local use of petroleum products through conservation measures and the use of alternative energy sources.

c. Advise the assembly on energy-related matters.

5. That the Committee hold public hearings to gather public input relating to the development of energy plans.

6. That the Committee perform other activities which are necessary and proper to carry out the above duties, and any other activities determined by the assembly to further the goal of energy conservation.

7. Staff support for the Committee shall be provided by the attorney's office for legal matters and by the manager for such other assistance and support as necessary.
