A RESOLUTION REGULATING SMOKING
IN THE ASSEMBLY CHAMBERS.

WHEREAS, some citizens of the City and Borough of Juneau smoke tobacco in various forms, and

WHEREAS, many citizens of the city and borough find smoking offensive,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:


1. That the smoking of cigars and pipes in the assembly chambers is prohibited.
2. That the smoking of cigarettes shall be permitted only in the southeast half of the assembly chambers, but including only that part of the assembly dais from and including the mayor's position to the southeast wall of the chambers.
3. That smoking shall be permitted in the hall and common areas adjacent to the assembly chambers.
4. That the manager shall post appropriate signs to implement this resolution.
5. That at the discretion of the chair, smoking may be prohibited in the assembly chambers for the sake of public health and convenience.
