A RESOLUTION RESERVING USS 1548 NEAR FISH CREEK FOR PARKS,
RECREATION, OPEN SPACE, AND CONSERVATION USES.

WHEREAS, the Georgia Pacific Corporation has
generously donated USS 1548 near Fish Creek to the City and
Borough of Juneau, and

WHEREAS, said parcel has been identified in the
Douglas Island comprehensive plan as being appropriated for
park purposes, and

WHEREAS, said parcel had been previously identi-
fied in the Capital Improvement Program for acquisition for
open space purposes, and


WHEREAS, the City and Borough Planning Commission
and the City and Borough Parks and Recreation Advisory
Committee have reviewed the newly acquired parcel, and

WHEREAS, both bodies recommend that the parcel be
reserved for park purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF
THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:


1. That USS Survey 1548 is reserved for park
purposes, including, but not limited to, recreation, camp-
ing, open space, conservation, and other uses not incon-
sistent with the foregoing.
2. That the manager or his designee may promul-
gate and post such rules or restrictions for the use of said
parcel as may be deemed appropriate.
