RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 639

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE TIME AND PLACE FOR COUNTING ACCEPTED CHALLENGED BALLOTS AND ABSENTEE BALLOTS CAST IN THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 28, 1980, AND APPOINTING JUDGES IN THE CITY AND BOROUGH PRECINCTS FOR SAID ELECTION.

WHEREAS, CBJ 29.05.200 provides that accepted challenged ballots and absentee ballots shall be counted by the city and borough election official and two or more assistants appointed by him, and

WHEREAS, said section further provides that such counting shall be done prior to the convening of the canvass board at a time and place designated by the assembly by resolution and shall be accomplished in public in full view of any persons assembled, and

WHEREAS, a special election is to be held on March 28, 1980, and

WHEREAS, judges for precincts must be appointed;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the accepted challenged ballots and the absentee ballots cast, but not previously counted, in the special election to be held on March 28, 1980, shall be counted as provided by ordinance by the city and borough election official at the assembly chambers in the Municipal Building, 155 South Seward Street, commencing at 1:00 p.m. on April 1, 1980.

2. That absentee ballots received in such election prior to the close of the polls shall be counted as provided by ordinance by the city and borough election official at the assembly chambers in the Municipal Building, 155 South Seward Street, commencing at the time the polls close.

3. That the following listed persons are appointed judges in the precincts as listed to constitute the election board in each of such precincts:
