A RESOLUTION REDUCING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE FROM FIFTEEN TO NINE.

WHEREAS, the assembly, by Resolution 141 established a Parks and Recreation Committee of fifteen members; and

WHEREAS, said committee has requested that its membership be reduced to nine; and

WHEREAS, such a reduction in membership appears to be reasonable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That Section 1 of Resolution 141 be amended to read:

1. That a Parks and Recreation Committee of nine members is hereby established to act in an advisory capacity for planning and development of all phases of juvenile and adult recreation.

2. That until the committee membership is reduced to nine through attrition, the membership of the committee shall be equal to such number of members as have not resigned or otherwise lost their membership on the committee.
