## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION SERIAL NOS. 510, 579, 624, AND 635; ADOPTING A NEW RATE STRUCTURE FOR THE USE OF FACILITIES AT THE EAGLECREST SKI AREA AND PROVIDING FOR A DISCOUNT FOR EARLY SEASON TICKET PURCHASERS.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a new rate \* structure for the use of facilities at Eaglecrest, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to consolidate all resolutions regarding rates applicable to the facilities at Eaglecrest in a single resolution, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to encourage the early purchase of season tickets by providing a 10% discount to early purchasers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

The following are charges for use of facilities and services at the Eaglecrest Ski Area:

1. Ski Lifts.

(a). Lift Tickets

(b). Lift Passes. Lift passes may be issued to ski patrol persons on the days of actual patrol duty and to ski instructors on the days of actual instruction.

(c). <u>Daily Ticket Discounts</u>. Discounts on daily tickets may be given as follows:

(1)	Number in group	Discount
	20 through 39 40 or more	5% 10%

(2) Discounts shall be available only for all-day or for night lift tickets and only when the sale is arranged in advance of the day for which the discount tickets are to be issued.

(3) Discount tickets will be issued only on the day of skiing and only to the person designated to represent the group.

(4) To qualify for a discount, the group must be one which is formally organized, has adopted a constitution and bylaws, has elected officers and holds bona fide meetings of the membership, or it must be a group assembled as a part of an advertised tour group or plan. The manager or his designee may demand proof of qualification of any group prior to authorizing a discount.

(5) The manager or his designee may establish such procedural and other requirements as deemed necessary to administer the sale and issuance of discount tickets and may make special arrangements to accommodate individuals who are participating in advertised tour packages which allow skiers to participate on an individual or other basis.

(d). <u>Season Ticket Discounts</u>. Season tickets may be purchased on or before November 15 for the coming ski season at a 10% discount.

(e). <u>Complimentary Breakdown Tickets</u>. All-day complimentary tickets will be issued to all patrons holding All-Day, All Lifts tickets if mechanical shutdown of both

chair lifts occurs within one hour after the time designated as the beginning of skiing for that day. All-day complimentary tickets will be issued to all patrons holding All-Day, Surface Lift tickets if mechanical shutdown of any surface lift scheduled for operation occurs within one hour after the time designated as the beginning of skiing for that day. Half-Day complimentary tickets will be issued similarly for shutdowns which occur between one and four hours after the time designated as the beginning of skiing for that day. Swing Shift complimentary tickets will be issued to all patrons holding Swing Shift tickets if mechanical shutdown of both chair lifts occurs within one and one-half . hours after the beginning of sale of the swing shift ticket. Night Lift complimentary tickets will be issued to all patrons holding Night Lift or Swing Shift tickets if mechanical shutdown of the lift occurs within one and one-half hours after the time designated as the beginning of night skiing. Purchased lift tickets must be turned in for complimentary tickets within one hour of shutdown. Complimentary tickets must be used during the season in which issued unless otherwise noted on the ticket.

(f). <u>Complimentary Promotional Tickets</u>. Complimentary lift tickets for one day only may be issued by the manager or his designee to persons who are visiting Eaglecrest for tour or promotional purposes and represent tour, tourrelated or promotional organizations.

(g). <u>Volunteer Tickets</u>. (1) Tickets in the form of an honorarium may be issued by the manager or his designee to volunteers as provided below:

(A) National Ski Patrol members who have patrolled Eaglecrest on a regular basis for less than one full season - one All-Day, All Lifts ticket for each two days of patrol performed.

(B) National Ski Patrol members who have patrolled Eaglecrest on a regular basis for one or more full seasons - one All-Day, All Lifts ticket for each day of patrol performed.

(C) Race officials of a scheduled race who have skiing duties during the race - one All-Day, All Lifts ticket for the day of the race.

(D) For local and visiting ski club ski coaches - one All-Day, All Lifts ticket for the day of the race and for any day the coach is substantially involved in training ski team skiers, provided, no club may receive more than two coach tickets per day.

(E) Race officials whose duties do not involve skiing - One transferable Half-Day, All Lifts or Night Lift ticket.

(h). <u>Ticket Refunds</u>. Cash refunds will not be granted for any reason for a lift ticket except as provided below:

(1) Refunds for season tickets may be granted for extenuating circumstances prior to the first day of operation of the ski season upon request. All such refunds are subject to a 10% charge for administrative costs.

(2) Refunds for individual season tickets will be granted after the first day of operations of the ski season only for medical reasons, verified by a physician. A request for refund for medical reasons must be submitted to the City and Borough of Juneau in writing within the first 60 days of the ski season and must relate to an incapacitating injury or illness which occurred within the first 30 days of the season. The amount refunded shall equal the All-Day, All Lifts ticket rate times the number of operating days the ticket is not used during the first 22 ski days after date of purchase.

(i). Definitions.

Adult - persons 18 years of age and older. Youth - persons under 18 years of age. All Lifts - chair and surface lifts. Surface Lifts - Mitey Mite and platter lift.

All-Day - The period of time from the daily commencement of operation to the time established by the manager or his designee as the time scheduled for closure of those runs not equipped for night skiing.

Holidays - includes all state holidays, the Friday following Thanksgiving and the period beginning with the Wednesday preceding Christmas day and running through January 1.

Half-Day - the period of time from a time to be established by the manager or his designee to the time scheduled for closure of those runs not equipped for night skiing.

Swing Shift - the period of time from a time to be established by the manager or his designee to the time scheduled for closure of those runs which are equipped for night skiing.

2. Lessons.

(a) Group Lessons

(b) Private Lessons

Private lessons are limited to a maximum of four (4) students.

(c) <u>Lesson Refunds</u>. A cash refund will be granted for prepaid lessons for reasons of illness or injury if notification of such is received prior to the first lesson.

3. Day Lodge Rental.

(a) Rental rates:

Each additional hour 10.00

Maximum charge per day 100.00

(b) Deposits:

Damage and theft deposit (refundable if no damage or theft occurs) \$100.00

Cleaning deposit (refundable if lodge is adequately cleaned after use and before next scheduled use) 30.00

4. Lockers.

Seasonal rental of a locker (under such terms, conditions, and priorities as the manager may establish) 30.00

5. Establishment and Adjustment of Certain Rates. (a) The manager or his designee is authorized to establish special rates for the purpose of promoting increased or safer use of Eaglecrest or any of its services. Such rates may be established for special events, lesson packages with or without lift privileges, and other services or activities. Such special rates may be less than the rates established elsewhere in this resolution.

(b) The manager or his designee is authorized to establish a schedule for the reduction of season rates based upon the estimated time remaining in the skiing season.

(c) The manager or his designee may establish interim rates to be applied to any new service or use at Eaglecrest. Such rates shall be effective until changed by the assembly by motion or resolution.

6. Resolutions 510, 579, 624, and 635 are repealed on the effective date of this resolution.

7. This Resolution shall become effective on May 22, 1980.
