A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE REGULAR MEETINGS IN THE MONTH OF JULY 1980 FROM JULY 3 TO JULY 10 AND FROM JULY 17 TO JULY 24.

WHEREAS, the assembly, by Resolution No. 245, has established the first and third Thursdays of each month as the dates for its regular meetings, and

WHEREAS, the first Thursday of July 1980 falls on the day before Independence Day, and

WHEREAS, it would be in the public interest for the assembly to reschedule the regular meetings of July to a date which does not conflict with this holiday, so that members of the public and the assembly may celebrate this day and attend and participate in such public ceremonies as may be scheduled, and

WHEREAS, by moving the first regular meeting there will be only one week between the first and second meetings, and

WHEREAS, as there are five Thursdays in July 1980, it would be in the public interest to move the second regular meeting to July 24 to provide a proper separation between meetings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the regular meetings for the month of July 1980 be held on July 10 and July 24, 1980.

2. That all matters scheduled to come before the assembly on July 3 and 17, 1980, are rescheduled to the July 10 and 24, 1980, meetings of the assembly respectively.
