RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 417  
TO INCREASE THE RATE OF COMPENSATION FOR  
MAINTENANCE OF SEWER FACILITIES BY CERTAIN  
DOWNHILL PUMPING SEWER USERS.

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau has recently recognized the increase in the cost of operating and maintaining the municipal sewer system, by adopting an increase in sewer service rates and charges by Resolution 673, and

WHEREAS, the cost of maintenance of certain municipal sewer facilities by downhill pumping sewer users has increased similarly, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau has decided by Resolution No. 417 that all users shall share equally the costs of operating and maintaining the municipal sewer system,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That effective retroactively to August 1, 1980, the rate of compensation to downhill pumping sewer users shall be increased by amending Section 4 of Resolution No. 417 to read as follows:

Downhill, pumping, sewer users  
shall be compensated in accordance  
with the following table:



2	15.31
3	16.46


4	\$ 17.60
5	18.75
6	22.50
7	26.50
8	30.00
9	33.75
10	37.50

For each additional sewer service unit over ten, the compensation shall be increased by \$3.00. The foregoing rate structure is based upon estimates of allowable operating expenses for acceptable pump pressure line installations. No allowance may be made for operation, maintenance, repair, or replacement costs which a gravity-flow sewer user would incur as a normal incident to a gravity flow system. The manager shall revise the rates from time to time based on substantial changes in the cost of operation and actual experience.
