RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 696 TO AUTHORIZE THE MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A LEASE OF MUNICIPAL LAND NEAR BARTLETT MEMORIAL HOSPITAL TO THE STATE OF ALASKA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING AND OPERATING A DIVERSION OR DETENTION CENTER FOR WOMEN, OR JUVENILES, OR BOTH.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 696 authorized the manager to negotiate and enter into a lease of a 1.112 acre parcel on U.S. Survey No. 1075 near Bartlett Memorial Hospital to the State of Alaska for a term of fifty-five years, such lease being for the purpose of constructing and operating a women's and juveniles' detention center, and

WHEREAS, it appears that future needs could require both diversion and detention services and that the center be limited to either women or juveniles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. Paragraph 1 of Resolution No. 696 is amended to read:

The Manager is authorized to negotiate and enter into a lease of the above-described parcel to the State of Alaska. Such lease shall be for the sole purpose of operating a diversion or detention center for women, or juveniles, or both, and shall be for an initial period of fifty-five years.
