WHEREAS, a special election is to be held on December 2, 1980, and

WHEREAS, judges for precincts must be appointed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the accepted challenged ballots and the absentee ballots cast, but not previously counted, in the special election to be held on December 2, 1980, shall be counted as provided by ordinance by the city and borough election official in the Municipal Building, 155 South Seward Street, in the Assembly Chambers, commencing at 1:00 p.m. on December 9, 1980.

2. That absentee ballots received in such election prior to the close of the polls shall be counted as provided by ordinance by the City and Borough Election Official in Room 131 of the Municipal Building, 155 South Seward Street, commencing at the time the polls close.
