RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 623
BY CHANGING THE MEMBERSHIP OF
THE ENERGY CONSERVATION COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the Assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau by Resolution No. 623 of December 6, 1979, established the Energy Conservation Committee to undertake conservation projects and to advise the assembly on energy-related matters, and

WHEREAS, the committee has experienced difficulty in gathering quorums for meetings and enlisting a sufficient number of people to assist it in carrying out projects, and

WHEREAS, a change in the membership of the committee appears to be the most effective way of reducing this difficulty.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That section 2 of Resolution No. 623 be amended to read as follows:

That the Committee shall consist of seventeen members to be representative of the general population and energy-related entities. Members shall be selected as follows:

a. Eleven representatives of the general public, including lower income persons, public transit users, and others with an interest in energy conservation, all to serve as voting members.

b. One bulk petroleum products distributor, to serve ex officio.

c. One retail gasoline distributor, to serve ex officio.
