RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 767

A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE INTENT OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU THAT LAND DISPOSAL PROGRAMS WILL BE UNDERTAKEN WHICH WILL MEET THE NEEDS OF PERSONS RESIDING IN THE CITY AND BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, under Ch 180 SLA 1978 (AS 29.18), the City and Borough of Juneau was given a land entitlement of 19,584 acres which could be selected from vacant, unappropriated and unreserved general grant lands of the State of Alaska, and

WHEREAS, mental health lands were not vacant, unappropriated and unreserved as defined in that act, and

WHEREAS, Ch 181 SLA 1978 had the effect of reclassifying mental health lands to make them available for selection by municipalities under their entitlement, and

WHEREAS, section 1(b) of Ch 181 SLA 1978 provides in pertinent part:

A municipality may select that former mental health land to satisfy its entitlement under AS 29.18 but title to the land may not be transferred to the municipality by the director until the governing body of the municipality certifies that disposal programs will be undertaken by the municipality which will meet the needs of persons residing in the municipality.

and

WHEREAS, it has been the intent of the City and Borough of Juneau to dispose of its entitlement lands to meet the needs of persons residing in the City and Borough of Juneau;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That the assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau certifies that land disposal programs will be undertaken by the city and borough which will meet the needs of persons residing in the city and borough.
