RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION AGENCY IN AN AMOUNT OF \$447,538 FOR THE ACQUISITION OF AIRPORT SNOW REMOVAL EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, the city and borough of Juneau, Alaska, has heretofore submitted an application to the Federal Aviation Agency (FAA) for a grant under the Airport and Airway Development Act of 1970 as amended, to aid in the financing of the acquisition of snow removal equipment for the Juneau International Airport identified as FAA Project No. ADAP 6-02-0133-12 and as City and Borough Public Works Project C.I.P. A-49, and

WHEREAS, the FAA has approved said application, and

WHEREAS, the assembly has allocated \$85,000 as its share of the required state and local match for the anticipated \$2,550,000 total grant, and

WHEREAS, the assembly of the city and borough approves said grant and authorizes the expenditure of the grant funds and the required local matching funds, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the public interest to make such acquisitions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That said agreement, a copy of which is attached and incorporated as if set out herein is in all respects approved by the assembly of the city and borough of Juneau, and the manager of the city and borough is authorized to execute said agreement and such other documents as are necessary to implement the grant. The manager of the city and borough or his designee or such officer as is required by law or regulation is authorized to do such acts as are required in execution of the grant agreement and the performance of its terms; further, the manager or his designee is authorized to execute such requisitions as may be required for payment from the FAA of funds pursuant to said agreement. The manager is authorized, without further assembly action, to accept and execute any amendments to the grant where the purpose of the amendment is to increase the grant amount, provided the terms and conditions are substantially the same and the assembly has allocated local funds to cover the required local match.
