RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (DOTPF) PERMIT THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU TO ASSUME THE DEPARTMENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES RELATING TO THE JUNEAU ELECTRIC POWERED TRANSIT FEASIBILITY STUDY.

WHEREAS, the Alaska Legislature has appropriated funds for the Juneau Electric Powered Transit Feasibility Study, and

WHEREAS, AS 35.15.080 provides that a municipality may, upon the concurrence of the Commissioner of DOTPF, assume the department's planning and construction responsibilities for public works projects of the state which are located within the municipality, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau has the authority to receive and expend such funds and to contract for the feasibility study, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau desires to assume the department's responsibilities for the feasibility study,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That, pursuant to AS 35.15.080, the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities is requested to execute one or more agreements with the City and Borough of Juneau which provide for the assumption by the city and borough of the department's responsibilities relating to the work to be accomplished under the DOTPF Juneau Electric Powered Transit Feasibility Study project.

2. That upon the execution of an agreement, the city and borough shall assume responsibility for the administration of the subject project and the funds.

3. That the manager of the City and Borough of Juneau or his designee shall be the coordinator for the project. Further, the manager is authorized to execute necessary agreements and to do all things necessary to comply with the lawful


requirements of the department, including, without limitation,
the designation of a project coordinator.
