RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 806

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE ALASKA STATEHOOD  
SILVER ANNIVERSARY ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the year 1984 will mark the twenty-fifth anniversary of Alaska Statehood, the bicentennial of the first permanent Russian settlement in Alaska established by Gregory Shelikof at Kodiak, and the centennial of the passage of the Alaska Organic Act, and

WHEREAS, these historical anniversaries, particularly the commemoration of Alaska's first quarter century as a member of the United States, combined to present Alaska and Juneau with a unique opportunity to both celebrate and inform others about our history and our unique and diverse cultures, and

WHEREAS, such commemorative celebration should have widespread community participation, and

WHEREAS, planning and preparation for such a commemorative celebration should commence well in advance of the celebration;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That there is hereby created the Alaska Statehood Silver Anniversary Advisory Committee.

2. That the committee shall consist of seven persons, appointed by the assembly, whose terms shall last until December 31, 1984 or when the duties established by this resolution are accomplished, whichever occurs first.

3. That the committee solicit public proposals and make recommendations to the assembly from time to time on the means and methods by which the community should commemorate and celebrate the silver anniversary of Alaska's statehood.

4. That the committee, with the approval of the assembly, coordinate and manage the Juneau celebration of the silver anniversary.


5. That the committee receive, for its own use, such gifts, donations, contributions, grants, and reimbursements as are appropriate for its function and purpose.

6. That the committee perform such additional relevant duties as the assembly may assign to it by motion or otherwise.
