RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (DOTPF) PERMIT THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU TO ASSUME THE DEPARTMENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES RELATING TO THE ACQUISITION OF TIDELANDS, AUKE BAY, AND AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO ACQUIRE THE PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the Alaska Legislature has appropriated funds for Acquisition of Tidelands, Auke Bay, and

WHEREAS, AS 35.15.080 provides that a municipality may, upon the concurrence of the Commissioner of DOTPF, assume the department's planning and construction responsibilities for public works projects of the state which are located within the municipality, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau has the authority to receive and expend such funds and to acquire such property, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau desires to assume the department's responsibilities for the acquisition of the Auke Bay tidelands;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That, pursuant to AS 35.15.080, the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities is requested to execute an agreement with the City and Borough of Juneau which provides for the assumption by the city and borough of the department's responsibilities relating to the Acquisition of Tidelands, Auke Bay project.

2. That upon the execution of an agreement, the city and borough shall assume the responsibility for the administration of the subject project and the funds.

3. That the manager of the City and Borough of Juneau or his designee shall be the coordinator for the project. Further, the manager is authorized to execute necessary agreements and to do all things necessary to comply with the lawful requirements of the department, including, without limitation, the designation of a project coordinator and the retention of such professional persons as he believes appropriate to accomplish the acquisition.

4. The manager may acquire the property designated by the DOTPF through negotiation at such price as he determines is just compensation.
