A RESOLUTION TO PLACE AN ADVISORY PROPOSITION  
RELATING TO AREAWIDE POLICE PROTECTION ON THE  
BALLOT FOR THE NEXT REGULAR ELECTION.

WHEREAS, police protection is provided by the municipality only in the Douglas and Juneau Service Areas, and

WHEREAS, a majority of the city and borough population resides outside these two areas, and

WHEREAS, the level of police protection provided by the State of Alaska is insufficient to meet the needs of such residents, and

WHEREAS, the municipal criminal and traffic codes are not enforced by the state troopers, and

WHEREAS, all citizens of the City and Borough of Juneau should receive adequate police protection, and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the area should be given an opportunity to express their desires relating to the extension of municipal police protection services to the area outside service areas 1 and 2,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the following advisory proposition shall be placed on the ballot at next regular municipal election to be held on October 5, 1982:
