Situational Update

There were no new COVID-19 cases announced for Juneau today. There were an additional 17 cases announced statewide for a total of which should bring the total cases up to 102.

EOC highlights

EOC efforts revolved around continuing operations and planning for sheltering needs. Furthered discussions were held with UAS and BRH around resources and needs.

Mt. Jumbo was set up for use as a quarantine facility.

Operations will continue tomorrow but planning efforts will take the day off unless something pops up that need attention.

Commenced effort to stand-up Quarantine Facility at Mt. Jumbo

Operational Highlights:

JNU Airport Screening

- 20 passengers screen (down from 30 yesterday)
- No total passenger count provided
- Alaska Air cancel some flights
- Reduced staffing to 4 screeners volunteers beginning to augment

Mobile Screening & Hotline

- Screened 22 callers
- Tested 12 drive throughs (zero home tests)
- 93 total screened and 39 tested this week

Homeless Task Force

• 29 clients at JACC

Quarantine Task Force

- 20 cots set up at Mt Jumbo
- Resource request submitted for staffing, janitorial cleaning and fence

Vessel Task Force

- 37 passenger + vehicles received COVID information
- Working with JNU Airport TF for volunteer staffing.
