RE:	City & Borough of Juneau COVID-19 Response – Emergency Operations Center Update

## **Situational Update**

There were no new Juneau cases announced today leaving our total at 5 positive cases of COVID-19 in the community. 1 person is housed at BRH and 1 was transported out of the community. The other three are isolating at home. There were 5 new statewide cases announced today bringing the total to 119.

## **EOC Highlights**

We had a joint EOC meeting today with BRH. Scheduled meeting with shelter providers in town. The EOC worked on the shelter/quarantine/isolation continuum, including meeting with members of the Glory Hall board and the Executive Director of AWARE. We continue to work toward resolving issues regarding sheltering and logistics for the population those groups support.

## **Operational Highlights**

Childcare: Details are starting to emerge about how to stand up childcare for essential workers.

<u>Isolation & Quarantine Taskforce</u>: Continues to plan for standing up a larger congregate setting that can be flexed to meet quarantine and isolation needs.

<u>Airport Screening</u>: 18 passengers screened. About 40% of those arriving took part. We anticipate 57 passengers today. On April 1, the number of flights will diminish. We will be evaluating on going operations to determine staffing levels and effectiveness of ongoing operations.

Mobile Screening: 13 hotline calls, tested 12 all at drive through. To date: 121 calls, 65 tests completed

Homeless: 49 at the JACC last night, and 38 during the day.

## Vessel Screening: 16 people from Haines

<u>BRH</u>: 1 positive case in the hospital, 2 close contacts to that individual are also in the hospital and have been tested for COVID 19. Those test results are pending. Physician education continues. Completing surge planning and beginning planning for Alternate Care facilities.
