EOC Highlights

EOC coordinated with BRH Case management about an individual currently experiencing homelessness that was tested for COVID – 19 and unable to effectively isolate on her own until the test results return. A care strategy was developed involving use of the overnight shelter and feeding.

Operational Highlights

CBJ operations continue with staff reassigned to EOC functions where appropriate. Minor staff outages due to childcare and medically advised quarantine. Staffing issues are not impairing operations.

Airport Screening: 10 passengers out of 34 arriving went through the voluntary screening process at the airport.

Mobile Screening: Did not receive numbers for screening calls. 8 tests at drive through, plus one at morgue. To date, sampled 106 for testing.

JACC: had 54 individuals overnight. Hours were extended at the JACC 8:00 pm to 8:00 am.

Vessel Screening: 17 passengers from Skagway. AMHS contemplating service on Friday/Saturday/Sunday only beginning April 10.
