## **Operational Highlights**

<u>Airport Screening</u>: 17 passengers out of 37 arriving went through the voluntary screening process at the airport.

<u>Mobile Screening</u>: Did not receive numbers for screening calls. 5 tests at drive through, plus one at morgue. To date, sampled 111 for testing.

April 5, 2020 Assembly EOC Update CBJ COVID-19 Response

<u>JACC</u>: had 39 individuals overnight. Hours were extended at the JACC 8:00 pm to 8:00 am. One person experiencing homelessness who has been tested for COVID-19, but pending results was housed overnight at Mt. Jumbo Gym.

<u>Vessel Screening</u>: 4 passengers from Hoonah. AMHS contemplating service on Friday/Saturday/Sunday only beginning April 10.
