Supply chain is operational with no significant reported shortages.

<u>CBJ operations</u> continue with staff reassigned to EOC functions where appropriate. Minor staff outages due to childcare and medically advised quarantine. Staffing issues are not impairing operations.

<u>BRH Operations</u> continue as normal. They have limited staff out due to illness or quarantine. Staffing issues are not impairing operations.

## **EOC Highlights**

EOC began Operational Period 8 (4/11/2020 - 4/16/2020), thereafter our operational periods will align with BRH. EOC is not meeting over the weekend.

Lemon Creek Correctional Facility: No update from LCCC.

## **Operational Highlights**

Airport Screening: 2 passengers out of 44 arriving went through the voluntary screening process at the airport.

Mobile Screening: 20 calls came into the call center. 14 tests at drive through. To date, sampled 161 for testing. 4 welfare checks were completed via phone.

<u>Vessel Screening</u>: 2 passengers arrived via ferry, both declined screening. Next ferry arrives on Friday.

Warming Shelter: had 57 individuals overnight.

Feeding Taskforce: Starting food operations at Zach Gordon covered play ground on Monday 3 meals per day.
