<u>CBJ operations</u> continue with staff reassigned to EOC functions where appropriate. Minor staff outages due to childcare and medically advised quarantine. Staffing issues are not impairing operations.

<u>BRH Operations</u> continue as normal. They have limited staff out due to illness or quarantine. Staffing issues are not impairing operations.

Supply chain is operational with no significant reported shortages.

EOC Highlights

Operational Period 9 (4/16/2020 – 4/23/2020).

<u>Health Mandate 14</u>: Still working with state officials on interpreting this mandate.

<u>Lemon Creek Correctional Center</u>: To date there have been 7 positive cases associated with LCCC. All employees, no inmates.

Operational Highlights

<u>Airport Screening</u>: 10 passengers out of 29 arriving went through the voluntary screening process at the airport.

Mobile Screening: over 48 calls came in to the call center, 13 of which were for screening for testing. There were 9 tests at drive through and 3 at home. To date, sampled 234 for testing. 2 welfare checks conducted via phone and 2 welfare checks in person. CARES transported 4 individuals.

Vessel Screening: Next ferry arrives on Friday.

Warming Shelter: had 52 individuals overnight.

Feeding Task Force: Meal count: 25 Breakfast, 40 lunch, 40 dinner.

<u>Centennial Hall</u>: Shower units are in process. Walk through with Fire Marshall went well. Staffing plan in early next week.

<u>Mill Campground</u>: Test platforms will be installed by end of the day. Will be opened next week. Hopefully by Monday.
