CBJ operations continue with staff reassigned to EOC functions where appropriate. Minor staff outages due to childcare and medically advised quarantine. Staffing issues are not impairing operations.

BRH Operations continue as normal. They have limited staff out due to illness or quarantine. Staffing issues are not impairing operations.

Supply chain is operational with no significant reported shortages.

EOC Highlights

Operational Period 9 (4/16/2020 – 4/23/2020).

EOC worked on preliminary criteria to move away from “hunker down.” There will be ongoing conversations around parameters that would need to be in place. The EOC will update the Assembly on April 27th.

Operational Highlights

Airport Screening: 8 passengers out of 39 arriving went through the voluntary screening process at the airport.

Mobile Screening: over 11 calls came in to the call center, 4 of which were referred to testing. There were 4 tests at drive through and 0 at home. To date, sampled 267 for testing. Anticipate an increase in testing for pre procedural testing.

Vessel Screening: 22 passengers arrived via ferry over the weekend.

Warming Shelter: had 55 individuals overnight.

Feeding Task Force: 20 Breakfast, 40 Lunch, 50 Dinners

Mt. Jumbo: 1 client at Mt. Jumbo. Had some roof issues. Need to get a repair done for the roof.

Centennial Hall: Small shower trailer is ready. Large shower trailer will be ready later this week.

Mill Campground: Quick interview with KTOO. One person showed up over the weekend. Saw several people headed that way. Porta-Potties are in. Streets graded and drained the area.

Distribution of hand sanitizer for the community. Working with Hecla for the raw materials. More sewers have volunteered to sew.
