Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 12 (5/07/2020 – 5/14/2020).

The EOC started a new Operational Period today.

Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

The number of COVID positive individuals currently identified in Juneau is 1 and that person is not physically in Juneau. DPH continues to follow 2 additional people for contact tracing. The overall numbers are increasing statewide at a very slow rate. Disease in the community is contained.

Testing:

Testing capacity and supplies remain good.

Hospital Response:



BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.

Issues of Note:

EOC continues to work through sheltering issues in general. We are working on the testing plan and associated logistics for the unsheltered population.

Operational Highlights

Airport Screening: provided quarantine information and Juneau specific COVID related materials to 100 arriving passengers.

Mobile Screening:

32 calls came into the hotline, 14 referred for testing, 14 appointments scheduled.

There were 13 tests at drive through, 6 of which were for medical related appointments. To date, sampled 390 for testing. 1 welfare check were completed via phone, 1 welfare check at the Driftwood.
