Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 13 (5/14/2020 – 5/28/2020).

Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

No new cases today. DPH continues to follow 3 individuals as PUIs.

Testing:

PCR testing capacity and supplies remain good for current levels of testing.

Hospital Response:

BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.

Issues of Note:

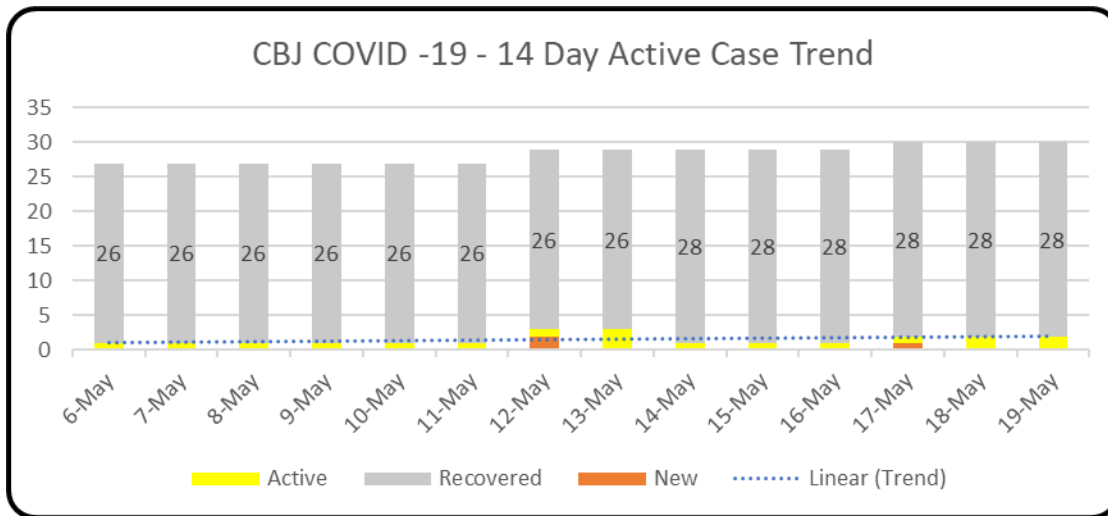
Testing for the shelter population begins tonight and carries through tomorrow.

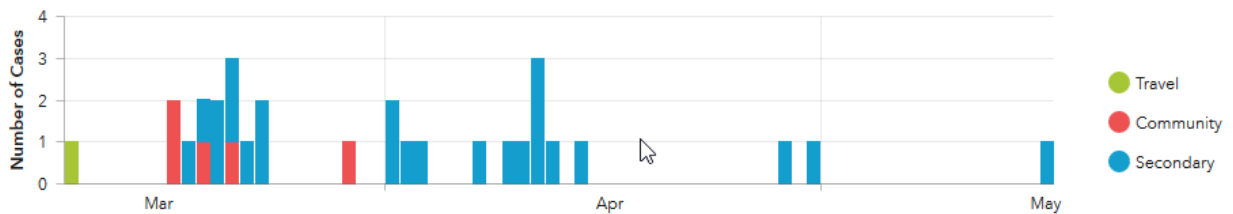

Operational Highlights

Airport Screening: 182 on Monday – we believe the increased numbers are related to the legislature. We are trying to get to a percentage of instate versus out of state numbers.

Vessel Screening: 33 from Skagway on Friday, 31 from Hoonah on Saturday, 50 from Haines on Sunday.

Mobile Screening/Community Paramedicine:

31 calls came into the hotline, 15 referred for testing, 15 appointments scheduled.

There were 19 tests over the weekend at the drive through, 11 of which were for medical related appointments. 3 were completed in home. To date, the Mobile Screening operation has sampled 528 for testing.

0 welfare checks were completed at home.

Tuesday Focus – Travel

The EOC has been tracking travel numbers and, as reported to the Assembly, numbers are starting to increase. This is to be expected given the time of year and the return of seasonal workforces. We do not have numbers from Alaska Airlines. However, the Airport does receive reports from TSA about numbers traveling out of the airport. Ms. Wahto reports that numbers clearing through security in Juneau are roughly equal to the numbers coming in.
