Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 13 (5/14/2020 – 5/28/2020).

Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

No new cases were reported today. DPH continues to follow 3 individuals as PUIs.

Testing:

PCR testing capacity and supplies remain good for current levels of testing. 22 additional individuals were tested as part of our shelter testing initiative, making a total of 78 people tested. 3 individuals over the course of both nights reported symptoms and are housed at Centennial Hall pending test results. We expect results to come in on Friday and Saturday.

Hospital Response:


BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.

Issues of Note:


Special Assembly meeting set up for Thursday, May 28th to discuss issues related to travel and other areas of COVID concern.

Operational Highlights

Airport Screening: 136 passengers flew in, 52 were from out of state.

Vessel Screening: Nothing to report.

Mobile Screening/Community Paramedicine:

31 calls came into the hotline, 26 referred for testing, 26 appointments scheduled.

There were 45 tests at the drive through, 16 of which were for medical related appointments, 6 for COVID related symptoms. 1 test was completed in home. 22 with the shelter population testing initiative. To date, the Mobile Screening operation has sampled 651 for testing.

3 welfare checks were completed at home.

Quarantine/Isolation: 3 clients as a result of the shelter screening event.
