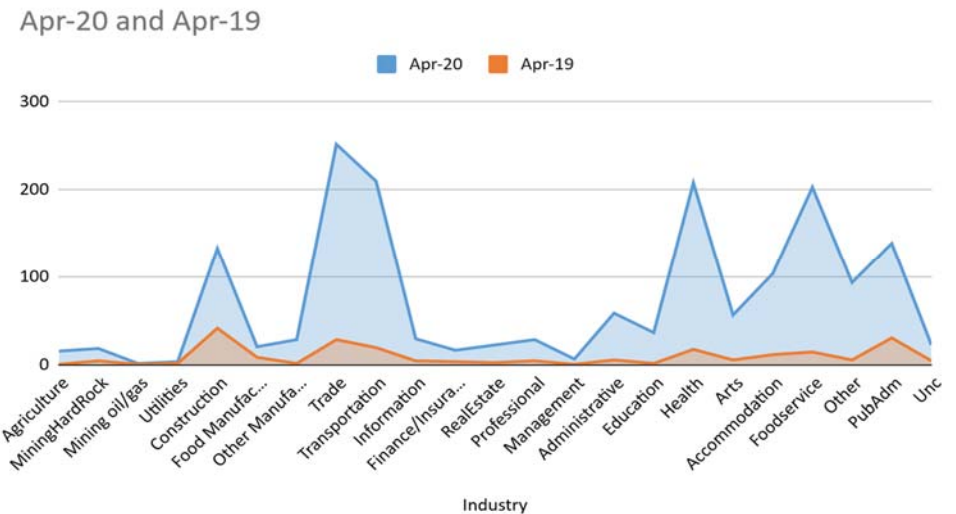
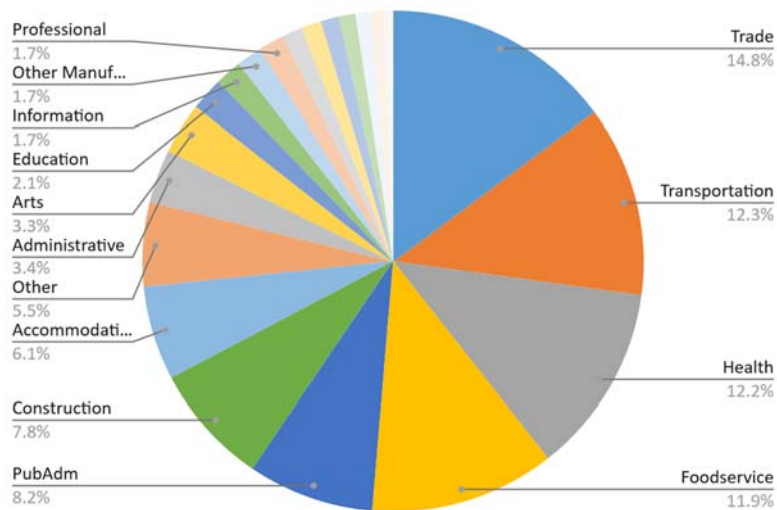


# Juneau Unemployment Data – April 2020
