## Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 14 (5/28/2020 – 6/11/2020).

## Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

One new Juneau cases today. Statewide, there was an increase of 8 positive cases for Alaska residents. Cumulatively 46 nonresidents have tested positive – none in Juneau. Contact tracing capability remains unconstrained.

## Testing:

PCR testing capacity and supplies remain good for current levels of testing. .

Hospital Response:


BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.

Issues of Note:

Airport testing went well yesterday. The taskforce reported good compliance and smooth operations. Overall, 76 tests were completed. We'll report on total number of passengers and tests on Monday.
