# Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 15 (6/11/2020 – 6/25/2020).

## Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

There was one new case in Juneau today and no new nonresident cases associated with Juneau. Contact tracing capability remains unconstrained. Disease acquisition is still under investigation.

## Testing:

We are experiencing delays in testing turnaround from both the state lab and commercial labs. We continue to explore ways to reduce the turnaround time for both.

Hospital Response:

BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.

Issues of Note:

We submitted a purchase order (PO) for one type of testing equipment today to get our place in line. We intend to do the same for at least two other types of equipment while planning and analysis work continues. There is no penalty for cancelling POs so long as it is done before the equipment ships.

Flawed sample tubes used at the airport resulted in some tests being rejected by the state lab. To the best of our knowledge, approximately 100 tests were impacted. Anyone that was impacted is being contacted directly to retest. The materials issue has been corrected and shouldn't be an issue moving forward.
