Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 16 (6/25/2020 – 7/9/2020).

<u>Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:</u>

There are no new resident cases reported in Juneau today and 48 new cases statewide. There are 7 new non-resident cases statewide, one of which is in Juneau.

Contact tracing capability remains unconstrained locally; however, contact tracing capability is strained statewide.

Testing:

Staff and supplies are unconstrained. There are episodic shortages that are appearing around the country related to reagent. We continue to monitor that as an issue.

Hospital Response:


BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.


Issues of Note:


There are three new statewide hospitalizations and one new statewide death being reported today.
