Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 16 (6/25/2020 – 7/9/2020).

Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

There are no new resident cases reported in Juneau today and 19 new cases statewide. There are additionally 4 new statewide non-resident cases, none in Juneau.

Testing:

Staff and collection supplies are unconstrained. Recent test turnaround times have been between 3 and 4 days.

Hospital Response:

BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.


Issues of Note:

Outside of operations, the EOC focus today has been on planning for the COVID-19 hotline transition when JSD nurses return to work.


Note that the Hospitalized COVID + number changed from cumulative to current today.
