Situational Update - Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 17 (7/9/2020 - 7/23/2020).

<u>Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:</u>

There are no new resident cases reported in Juneau today and 46 new cases statewide. There are additionally 3 new statewide non-resident cases, none in Juneau.

Testing:

Staff and collection supplies are unconstrained. Recent test turnaround times have been between 3 and 7 days.

Hospital Response:

BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.


<u>Issues of Note:</u>

The EOC focus today has been on planning for the COVID-19 hotline transition as well as continued planning for local testing.


FYI as it's been a common question: to date, 91 business grants have been approved through JEDC. 75 are under review and they are continuing to receive new applications.


Acquisition of COVID-19
