RE: City & Borough of Juneau COVID-19 Response – Emergency Operations Center Update

Situational Update - Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 18 (7/23/2020 – 8/6/2020).

<u>Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:</u>

The state is reporting 59 new statewide resident cases and 7 new statewide non-resident cases. Within these numbers, 2 resident and no non-resident are attributed to Juneau. The EOC numbers in the table below don't match the state reported numbers today – the EOC has access to more timely data and our numbers continue to reflect that information.

Contact tracing continues to be strained statewide. DPH reported that they are following 49 individuals locally. This includes all contacts as a result of the AGS cluster.

Testing:

Staff and collection supplies are unconstrained. CBJ Testing operations is reporting the significant majority of tests yesterday were from July 20th, with the spread being as little as 4 days and as much as 9 days. We do not have access to turnaround times from private providers. Test results from the most recent round of AGS testing are expected over the weekend.

Hospital Response:

BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.


<u>Issues of Note:</u>

We continue to get general questions about masking and are working through related issues as they arise. We continue to work with AGS in helping them manage issues associated with their workplace cluster.





Acquisition of COVID-19
