RE: City & Borough of Juneau COVID-19 Response – Emergency Operations Center Update

Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 18 (7/23/2020 – 8/6/2020).

<u>Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:</u>

The state is reporting 147 new statewide resident cases and 4 new statewide non-resident cases. Within these numbers, 0 resident and 2 non-resident cases are attributed to Juneau.

The CBJ EOC numbers differ from the state dashboard due to more timely reporting. Locally, we are reporting 2 new resident and 1 nonresident case. Sources of transmission for the resident cases are 1 secondary transmission and 1 out of state travel. The new nonresident case is associated with the AGS cluster.

DPH reports they are tracking 22 PUIs. AGS continues to monitor 36 employees as close contacts.

Testing:

Staff and collection supplies are unconstrained. 174 tests were returned yesterday, ranging in date from July 25th through July 28th. I did not receive a break down by date.

Hospital Response:

BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.




The EOC is working on updated risk matrix, dashboard, and community impact.

Numbers changed from yesterday are highlighted. We did receive DPH numbers today.



This chart tracks the number of new cases in the past 7 days, controlled for population. Other than Alaskan boroughs, King County (Seattle) and Multnomah County (Portland) are included for context and due to travel frequency.

The source data for Alaska is from the SOA dashboard. Out of state data is from the Harvard Global Health Institute (https://globalepidemics.org/key-metrics-for-covid-suppression/) and is generally lags a day behind most of our other reporting.
