## Situational Update – Incident Level 2 - Operational Period 18 (7/23/2020 – 8/6/2020).

## Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

The state is reporting 145 new statewide resident cases and 13 new statewide non-resident cases. Within these numbers, 1 resident and 0 non-resident cases are attributed to Juneau.

The CBJ EOC numbers differ from the state dashboard due to more timely reporting. Locally, we are reporting 0 resident and 0 nonresident cases.

DPH reports they are tracking 22 PUIs. AGS continues to monitor 36 employees as close contacts.

## Testing:

Staff and collection supplies have episodic interruptions, but test results continue to come in generally in the 3-6 day range. 176 test results were received yesterday, with tests originally collected on July 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>. This represents a 2-3 day turnaround time.

## Hospital Response:

BRH reports adequate supply of PPE and no concerns related to workforce availability.


Issues of Note:

Numbers changed from yesterday are highlighted. DPH did not update numbers today.



This chart tracks the number of new cases in the past 7 days, controlled for population. Other than Alaskan boroughs, King County (Seattle) and Multnomah County (Portland) are included for context and due to travel frequency.

The source data for Alaska is from the SOA dashboard. Out of state data is from the Harvard Global Health Institute (<u>https://globalepidemics.org/key-metrics-for-covid-suppression/</u>) and is generally lags a day behind most of our other reporting.
