Testing Information: In order to test as an entry level police officer for the Juneau Police Department, all applicants must register at www.PublicSafetyTesting.com and select a date/location for their test.

* Applicants are not required to test in Juneau; applicants may test at any testing location offered by Public Safety Testing. Both the written test & the physical fitness agility test must be completed before proceeding in the recruitment process.

A sample schedule for testing in Juneau is as follows:

Wednesday: 0830 hours – Check-in for testing which will begin at 0900 and end at approximately 1300.

Thursday: 0900 hours - Physical Fitness Agility Test (time needed depends on the number of candidates, approximately 1-2 hours)

Thursday: 1200 hours - Oral Board interviews (1 hour per candidate, scheduled every hour, beginning at 1300 hours).

Friday: 0800 hours - Oral Board interviews continued (1 hour per candidate, scheduled every hour, beginning at 0800 hours).

Friday: 1200 hours - PHQ/SAR written testing (approximately 3 hours)
