Situation Assessment: Our 7 and 14 day case rate indicators are in the very high alert level range. The disease is moving via travel and family groupings. Contact tracing is impaired due to caseloads statewide and the nature of contacts required. Residents must take appropriate cautions, including limiting social bubbles to immediate family members.

Issues of Note:

Cases continue to climb around the state – today DHSS reported 551 new cases. Anchorage hospitals are near capacity and we are tracking that closely to understand the impact on local ability to medevac.

The UAS cluster is evolving. Currently there are 7 COVID positive cases (6 in town, 1 out of town). One case has recovered. Our mobile testing team tested 35 people on campus yesterday. We expect test results back on Thursday afternoon or Friday morning.

DHSS has changed their reporting protocols for 7 day and 14 day population adjusted counts. We are rethinking how to present this information. Until we settle on a new process, that graph will not be presented as a part of this report.

Daily Numbers Report:

We are reporting 10 new cases today.

<u>Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:</u>

We are reporting 10 new resident cases and no new nonresident cases today: 2 are secondary transmission, 2, are travel related, 1 is community spread, and the remaining cases are under investigation.

The State of Alaska is reporting 551 new cases today bringing the statewide cumulative case count to 25,588.

<u>Testing</u>: In total 161 test results were received with collection dates of 11/10/2020 - 11/15/2020, returning results to individuals 2-7 days after collection.

- 64 test results were received from the Alaska State Lab with a collection dates of 11/10/2020 11/13/2020 returning results to individuals 4-7 days after collection.
- 97 test results were received from the Fulgent Lab with collection dates of 11/14/2020 11/15/2020, returning results to individuals 2-3 days after collection.
