**Situation Assessment:** Our 7 and 14 day case rate indicators are in the very high alert level range. The disease is moving via travel and family groupings. Community spread is increasing. Contact tracing is impaired due to caseloads statewide and the nature of contacts required. Residents must take appropriate cautions, including limiting social bubbles to immediate family members.

**Issues of Note:**

The rolling 7 day average for cases in metropolitan areas in the state are beginning to level out. Overall positivity remains high. Today, DHSS reported 637 new cases. The hospital system in Alaska continues to be overburdened, Seattle hospitals are tight for space as well. However, medevacs are still being accepted and BRH is working closely with those hospitals to track capacity.

We are beginning to see test results from the outstanding batches processed by the State Lab. The Fulgent Lab process is running smoothly with turnaround times in the 2 – 3 day range.

**Daily Numbers Report:**

We are reporting no new cases today. Numbers are not available from our local DPH Office and the CBJ dashboard is still reporting cases ahead of the state dashboard.

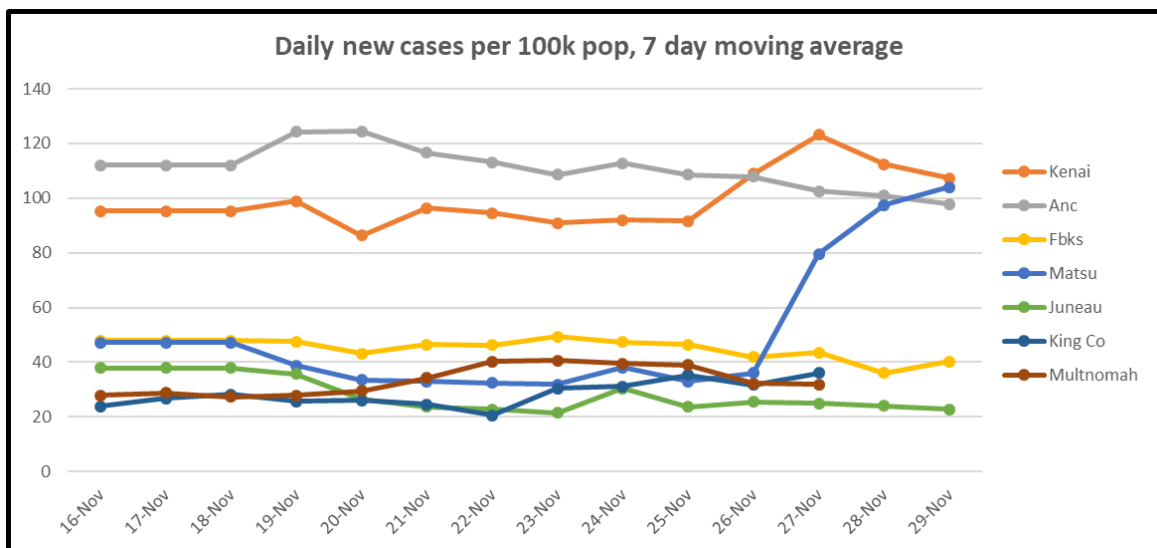
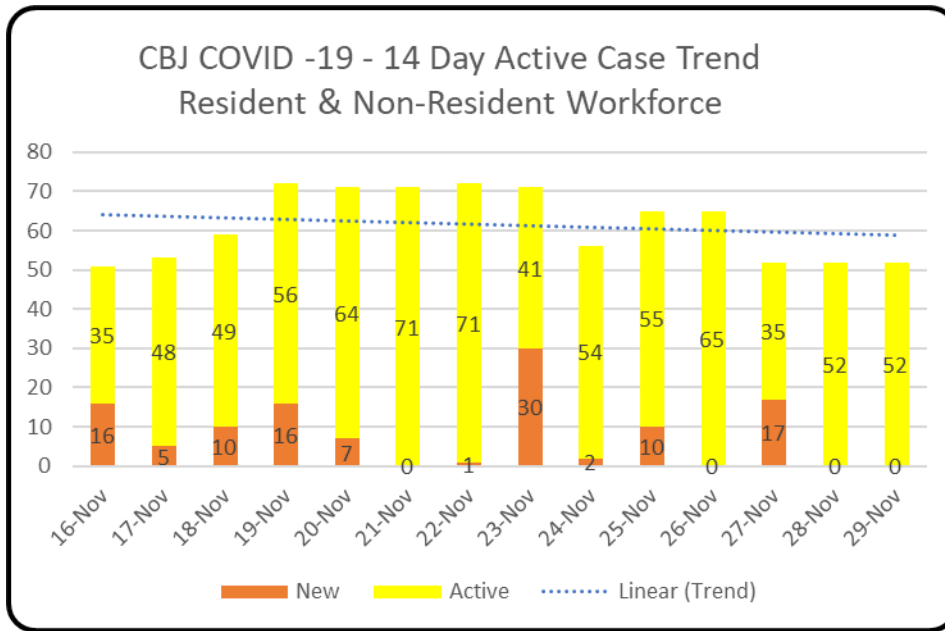

Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

The State of Alaska is reporting 637 new cases today bringing the statewide cumulative case count to 32,065.

Testing: Testing data will be reported on Monday, November 30<sup>th</sup>.



This chart tracks the number of new cases in the past 7 days, controlled for population. King County (Seattle) and Multnomah County (Portland) are included for context and due to travel frequency. The source data for Alaska is from the SOA dashboard. Out of state data is from the Harvard Global Health Institute (<https://globalepidemics.org/key-metrics-for-covid-suppression/>) and generally lags a day behind most of our other reporting.
