RE: Situational Update –Level 3 High- Operational Period 28 (12/31/2020 – 1/28/2021)

Situation Assessment: Our 14 day case rate is at the High alert level and our 7 day case rates has dropped to the Moderate alert level. The disease is moving across all disease acquisition types: secondary infection, travel and community. Travel related cases remain elevated. Residents must take appropriate cautions, including limiting social bubbles to immediate family members. The public should strictly adhere to all health orders related to travel.

Issues of Note:

Testing:

Asymptomatic testing is under way at the Fire Training Center. Total tested so far is 724. 519 tests have been processed, with 4 tests returning positive. The asymptomatic testing event will run through Jan. 10th.

Vaccines:

The State has published guidance on what populations will be included in Phase 1b. Phase 1b, Tier 1 will include all people who are 65+. The state has made registration available to those individuals in that age group beginning on Wednesday January 6th at noon with vaccinations as early as January 11th.

Vaccinations are currently happening for Phase 1a, Tier 3 – health care workers.

The EOC is planning for mass Point of Dispensing events in the eventuality the community has access to a sufficient number of vaccine doses to warrant such an event. Planning includes location, staffing, registration detail and other technology support, as well as specific logistics related to potential populations served.




<u>Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:</u>

We are reporting 1 new resident case and no new nonresident cases. The case is considered secondary transmission.

The State is reporting 206 new cases today for a cumulative total of 48,560 cases.

<u>Testing</u>: 01/04/2021: 97 test results were received from the Fulgent Lab with collection dates between 12/31/2020 – 01/02/2021 – 28 tests returned in 2 days, 68 tests returned in 3 days, and 1 test returned in 4 days.
