Situation Assessment: Our 14 day and 7 day case rates are at the Moderate alert

level. The disease continues to move across all disease acquisition types: community spread, secondary transmission, and travel. We caution the public to strictly adhere to all health orders related to travel and to continue strict adherence to masking and social distancing when outside your immediate home.

## **Issues of Note:**

Our first mass Point of Dispensing (POD) is underway at Centennial Hall. We anticipate vaccinating 1100 individuals over the course of the event which concludes on Sunday. The operation ran smoothly on Friday night with lots of positive feedback. Total vaccination numbers will be given Sunday or Monday. We anticipate vaccinating 1100 people.

## **Daily Numbers Report:**

We are reporting 1 new cases today. Note: The state dashboard is reporting 1 more case for Juneau today. Local DPH officials believe there is a discrepancy in the state reporting. This may take a few days to iron out.



## Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:


We are reporting 1 new resident case and no new nonresident cases today. The new case is under investigation.


The State is reporting 195 new cases today bringing the statewide cumulative total to 51,653 cases.

This chart tracks the number of new cases in the past 7 days, controlled for population. King County (Seattle) and Multnomah County (Portland) are included for context and due to travel frequency. The source data for Alaska is from the SOA dashboard. Out of state data is from the Harvard Global Health Institute (https://globalepidemics.org/keymetrics-for-covid-suppression/) and generally lags a day behind most of our other reporting.
