Situation Assessment: Our 14 day case rate is at the Moderate level and our 7 day case rates is in the High level. The disease continues to move across all disease acquisition types: community spread, secondary transmission, and travel. We caution the public to strictly adhere to all health orders related to travel and to continue strict adherence to masking and social distancing when outside your immediate home.

Issues of Note:

Our first mass Point of Dispensing (POD) was a success. Operations went smoothly and overall, 1,182 doses were dispensed. The follow up clinic for the second does will be held February 5 – 7 at Centennial Hall.

We are seeing a slight uptick of positive cases and our 7 day case average pushed into the High Level. The EOC will talk with DPH on Tuesday to determine case acquisition.

There were no positive cases attributed to the special testing effort with persons experiencing homelessness.

Daily Numbers Report:

We are reporting 2 new cases today. Note: The state dashboard is reporting 1 more case for Juneau today. Local DPH officials believe there is a discrepancy in the state reporting. This may take a few days to iron out.



Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:


We are reporting 2 new resident cases and no new nonresident cases today. The new case is under investigation.


The State is reporting 153 new cases today bringing the statewide cumulative total to 52,093 cases.
