RE: **Situational Update –Level 2 Moderate-** Operational Period 28 (12/31/2020 – 1/28/2021)

**Situation Assessment:** Our 14 day and 7 day case rate indicators have elevated to the High level. The disease continues to move across all disease acquisition types: community spread, secondary transmission, and travel. We caution the public to strictly adhere to all health orders related to travel and to continue strict adherence to masking and social distancing when outside your immediate home.

**Issues of Note:**

We are seeing an uptick in cases. Based on discussions with Public Health remaining in Moderate status is still appropriate. A lot of case activity is secondary infection or travel (people that should already be following quarantine strategies) and not significant community spread. The EOC will continue to monitor and adjust as appropriate.

The EOC has received questions about who is included in our numbers: The resident count includes Juneau residents in Juneau, Juneau residents outside of Juneau, and Alaska residents currently located in Juneau. This differs from how the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services counts cases. DHSS bases the location of the case on the resident's permanent address. When CBJ's resident count includes Juneau residents outside of Juneau, it is noted within the case count update. The nonresident count is made up entirely of non-Alaska residents who are in Juneau.

**Daily Numbers Report:**

We are reporting 4 new cases today. One case is an older one that wasn't previously reported.

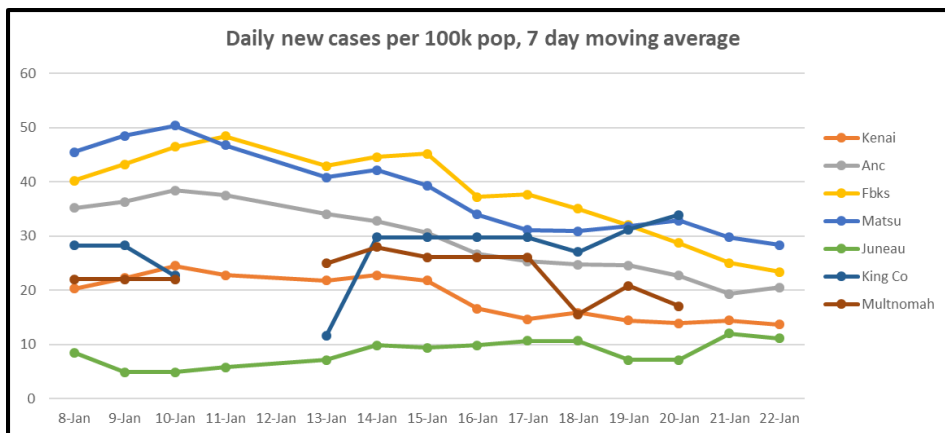
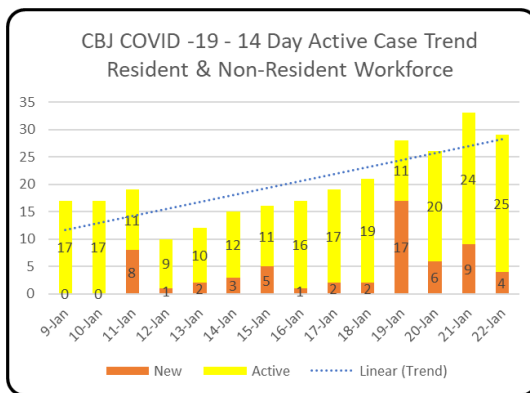
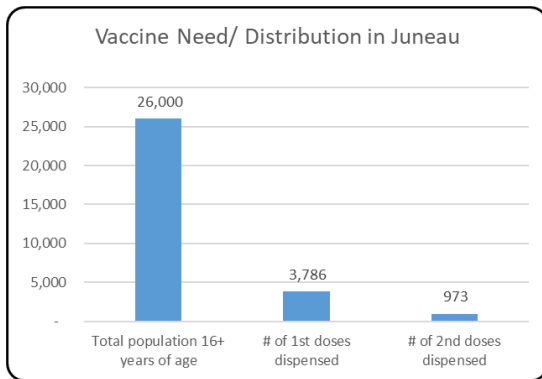

Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

We are reporting 2 new resident cases and 2 new nonresident cases today. Both resident cases are community spread. Both nonresident cases are travel related. One is current and the other is an old case that was not previously reported. It is listed today as a new case and also as a recovered case.

The State is reporting 290 new cases today bringing the statewide cumulative total to 52,901 cases.

Testing: 1/21/2021: 20 test result was received from the Fulgent Lab with a collection date of 01/19/2021 - all tests were returned in 2 days.



This chart tracks the number of new cases in the past 7 days, controlled for population. King County (Seattle) and Multnomah County (Portland) are included for context and due to travel frequency. The source data for Alaska is from the SOA dashboard. Out of state data is from the Harvard Global Health Institute (<https://globalepidemics.org/key-metrics-for-covid-suppression/>) and generally lags a day behind most of our other reporting. Policy recommendations at varying levels (<1, <10, <25, 25+) can be found on their website
