Situation Assessment: Our 14 day and 7 day case rate indicators are in the High Alert level. The disease continues to move across all disease acquisition types: community spread, secondary transmission, and travel. A more aggressive strain of COVID-19 has been identified in Alaska. We caution the public to strictly adhere to all health orders related to travel and to continue strict adherence to masking and social distancing when outside your immediate home.

Issues of Note:

The State of Alaska announced that they would no longer update the COVID dashboard over weekends and holidays. Because the state dashboard provides the data we report over the weekend, CBJ will no longer provide EOC updates over the weekend. If there is a significant event that requires immediate attention, the Assembly will be notified and an information release will be put out for the public.

Vaccine updates: 20.1% of the Juneau population age 16 and above have been vaccinated with 6% of the population having received their 2nd dose.

Registration for POD 2 is underway. The POD is currently open to healthcare workers and community members 65 years of age and up. There are about 500 appointments available.

Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:

We are reporting 3 new resident cases and 1 new non resident case. All cases are secondary transmission. 2 of the cases are associated with the mining industry and the individuals who tested positive had been in quarantine.

The State is reporting 140 new cases today bringing the statewide cumulative total to 54,594 cases.

<u>Testing</u>: 2/01/21: 66 test results were received from the Fulgent Lab with collection dates between 01/26/2021 - 01/30/2021 - 15 tests returned in 2 days, 50 tests returned in 3 days, and 1 test returned in 6 days. Please note: We are in the process of determining how to report out airport testing with the conversion of operations to Capstone.
