**Situation Assessment:** 14 day and 7 day case rates have dropped to the minimal alert level. The community continues to see COVID spread in the community with a higher proportion of cases occurring in youth under the age of 19. Two variants of concern have been identified in Juneau - (UK/B1.1.7 and Brazil/P1). Case rates statewide are declining.

## **Issues of Note:**

May clinics have concluded. In all, 85 first doses were administered this week at the two public clinics – one at True North Federal Credit Union and the other at the Juneau Public Health Center.

CBJ is partnering with the Chamber of Commerce to incentivize vaccinations in the month of June. The Chamber is providing \$20 gift cards for anyone receiving a first dose in June. Gift cards are available from a variety of Juneau Businesses. In addition, any one who receives a first or second dose between June 1<sup>st</sup> and June 29<sup>th</sup> will also be entered into a drawing for a \$1,000 prize. In all, 5 \$1,000 prizes will be awarded.



## <u>Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:</u>

We are reporting 4 new resident cases and no new nonresident cases. 2 cases are community spread, 1 case is secondary infection and the remaining case is under investigation.

That State is reporting 41 new cases today bringing the statewide total to 70,208 cases. This is a total of 89 new cases since the last EOC report.


Testing: 70 COVID tests were processed at BRH since the last EOC report, all tests returned in less than 24 hours.




Total: **63.9%** of the of the total population of Juneau has received at least 1 dose of vaccine and **58.4%** have completed their vaccine series.

12+: **74.5**% of the age eligible Juneau population has received at least 1 dose of vaccine. **68.1**% have completed their vaccine series.

65+: **89%** of this age group has at least one dose of vaccine. **87%** have completed the vaccine series. (State updated dashboard)





This chart tracks the number of new cases in the past 7 days, controlled for population. King County (Seattle) and Multnomah County (Portland) are included for context and due to travel frequency. The source data for Alaska is from the SOA dashboard. Out of state data is from the Harvard Global Health Institute (https://globalepidemics.org/keymetrics-for-covid-suppression/) and generally lags a day behind most of our other reporting.
