Covid-19 mitigation plan, 03-05-2021

City and Borough of Juneau Risk Level 1

The Jensen-Olson Arboretum is open to the public Wednesday through Sunday. The arboretum is an open air facility with no indoor facilities to maintain except in summer. The guest restroom, open March – November, will be maintained daily and as needed. Events at the arboretum will be held with numbers limited to allow for adequate social distancing. Events and rentals are limited to 50 attendees per CBJ regulations. However, all state and/or local mandates supersede existing policies.

Please be aware of and follow CDC guidelines to prevent the spread of coronavirus.

All visitors to the arboretum are expected to follow current state and local health mandates and guidelines at the facility.

No person diagnosed with or exhibiting symptoms of Covid-19 is allowed to enter the Arboretum.

Face masks are required to enter the Arboretum for organized events, or in the case of groups from different households meeting.

Physical distancing—spacing of six-feet apart between visitors—must be maintained between individuals of different households and household groups

Touch-point sanitation is completed weekly and as needed by trained staff. This includes the guest restroom and guest sign-in book and other items as needed.

Groups holding events or renting space will be asked to provide their own Covid mitigation plan to JOA prior to finalizing reservations.

Groups holding events will be required to provide hand sanitizer and masks for visitors who do not arrive with their own mask. A group may be but is not limited to: Friends of the Jensen-Olson Arboretum; wedding ceremony reservations; and children or adult workshops.

Contact tracing information will be taken during on-site events organized by FJOA, CBJ, or any other responsible party. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Jensen-Olson Arboretum will update this mitigation plan as needed based on CBJ guidelines and risk level.

This current mitigation plan is based on the City and Borough of Juneau's risk level 1 declaration.
