Situation Assessment: 14 day case rates are at the minimal alert level and our 7 day case rates are at the moderate alert level. The community continues to see COVID spread in the community with a higher proportion of cases occurring in youth under the age of 19. Three variants of concern have been identified in Juneau - (UK/B1.1.7, South Africa/B.1.351, and Brazil/P1). Case rates statewide are declining.




Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:


We are reporting 3 new resident cases and 1 new nonresident case. 3 cases are secondary infection and the remaining case is under investigation. A new cluster has been identified that accounts for some of the new cases reported yesterday and today. The cluster is a small day care and so far has resulted in 6 positive cases.

That State is reporting 34 new cases today bringing the statewide total to 70,355 cases.

Testing: 95 COVID tests were processed at BRH since the last EOC report, all tests returned in less than 24 hours.







This chart tracks the number of new cases in the past 7 days, controlled for population. King County (Seattle) and Multnomah County (Portland) are included for context and due to travel frequency. The source data for Alaska is from the SOA dashboard. Out of state data is from the Harvard Global Health Institute (https://globalepidemics.org/key-
