## RE: Situational Update –Level 1 Minimal- Operational Period 33 (05/20/21 – 06/30/21)

**Situation Assessment:** 14 and 7 day case rates are at the moderate alert level. The community continues to see COVID spread in the community with a higher proportion of cases occurring in youth under the age of 19. Three variants of concern have been identified in Juneau - (Alpha/B.1.1.7, Beta/B.1.351, and Gamma/P1). Case rates statewide are declining.

## **Issues of Note:**

Case rates have jumped compared to the last several weeks. However, most case positivity is being driven through small groups of secondary infection. This includes the day care cluster, a family grouping, and another grouping of cases not yet designated as a cluster.

The follow up clinics at the high schools today administered 131 doses. Second dose clinics at the middle schools are scheduled for Monday, June 7<sup>th</sup>.




## Disease Transmission/Contact Tracing:


We are reporting 9 new resident cases and 1 new nonresident case. 8 cases are secondary infection, 1 travel related, and the remaining case is under investigation. The daycare cluster so far has resulted in 8 positive cases, no cases have yet recovered.

That State is reporting 60 new cases today bringing the statewide total to 70,355 cases. This is 114 new cases since the last EOC report.

Testing: 192 COVID tests were processed at BRH since the last EOC report, all tests returned in less than 24 hours.







This chart tracks the number of new cases in the past 7 days, controlled for population. King County (Seattle) and Multnomah County (Portland) are included for context and due to travel frequency. The source data for Alaska is from the SOA dashboard. Out of state data is from the Harvard Global Health Institute (https://globalepidemics.org/keymetrics-for-covid-suppression/) and generally lags a day behind most of our other reporting. Policy recommendations at varying levels (<1, <10, <25, 25+) can be found on their website
