Juneau Proclamation Commemorating Earth Day, Litter Free Juneau and Drive Electric Earth Day April 30, 2022

April __, 2022

Whereas, the City and Borough of Juneau is a demonstrated national leader in energy-efficient heating technologies such as the Ted Stevens Marine Research Center Seawater Heat pump, the Juneau Airport and several other public facilities on Ground Source Heat Pumps, and community effort to expand usage of Air Source Heat Pumps through Alaska Heat Smart;

Whereas, the City and Borough of Juneau is a demonstrated national leader in electric vehicle adoption through an array of public charging stations and operates Alaska's first public transportation electric bus; and

Whereas, the City and Borough of Juneau have resolutions and actively executing strategies and goals outlined in our Juneau Climate Action and Implementation Plan and our Juneau Renewable Energy Strategy; and

Whereas, the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska, has demonstrated Alaskan and North American leadership with public policy supporting electric vehicles and the transformation of fossil fuel transportation to clean, sustainable and locally-produced hydropower that reduces the cost of transportation in Juneau and also keeps these energy dollars circulating in Juneau; and

Whereas, Litter Free Juneau is an annual clean-up Juneau event with hundreds of volunteers that pick up tons of trash along our street corridors, public parks, walkways, streets and highways; and

Whereas, the Downtown Business Association and Juneau Electric Vehicle Association have teamed up to take a historical EV photo of Juneau EV's parked on South Franklin Street at 8 AM on April 30 during the Litter Free clean-up day; and

Whereas, this local event and participation of the Juneau Electric Vehicle Association is recognized as a Juneau Drive Electric Earth Day event with Plug-in America; and

Whereas, the Juneau Commission on Sustainability recommends that the CBJ put forward a proclamation commemorating the April 30 Litter Free event as a component of Juneau's Earth Day celebration with vibrant local support. **Now, therefore**, I, Beth Weldon, the Mayor of the City and Borough of Juneau, do hereby proclaim a Juneau commemoration of Earth Day, April 30, 2022, "As Commemorating Earth Day, Litter Free Juneau and Drive Electric Earth Day April 30, 2022, and thanking all participatory organizations, sponsors and volunteers for helping to make Juneau the finest and cleanest Capital City in the U.S. I ask all residents to consider participating this year in the annual Litter Free Juneau clean-up, electric vehicle commemorative picture and call upon all residents of Alaska's Capital City to join me in celebrating Juneau's leadership on Earth Day by cleaning up our community.
