## ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2022-39

An Ordinance Amending Prohibited Acts within the Boat Harbor Related to Dogs and Other Domestic Animals.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

**Section 1.** Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the City and Borough of Juneau Municipal Code.

**Section 2. Amendment of Section.** CBJC 85.25.090 Prohibited acts, is amended to read:

## 85.25.090 Prohibited acts.

It is unlawful for any owner, master, operator or managing agent or other person to commit any of the following acts within the boat harbor:

•••

(7) To allow or permit any dog or other domestic animal to be tethered or restrained to any part of a float or ramp. If a dog or other domestic animal urinates on a float or ramp, the urine must be cleaned up by the application of water in an amount sufficient to eradicate the urine. If a dog or other domestic animal defecates on a float, ramp, or any other area of the harbor including the parking lot, the feces must be cleaned up immediately and disposed of in a proper trash receptacle. All dogs must be leashed in such a manner that a person capable of controlling the dog is able to maintain positive control of them while on the dock, and in compliance with CBJC 08.40.020.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be effective 30 days after its adoption.
